City Tour Programs in Yangon, Bago, Kyeikhtiyo, Mandalay, Bagan

1. Yangon Half Day Sightseeing



1) Shwedagone Pagoda which enshrines strands of Buddha's hair and other holy relics. The Shwedagon Pagoda consists hundreds colorful temples, stupas, and statues that reflects the architectural era spanning almost a 2,500 years.

2) The MahaWizaya Pagoda in Yangon is a very elegant structure on top of a small hill. Among the very colorful murals in the central dome are depictions of the Buddha meditating under a Bodhi tree.

3) Scotts (BogyokeAung San) Market is an old colonial building which is popular shopping centers for Wood Carvings, Art Galleries, Antique handicrafts, Lacquerware, clothing, fabrics, Gem & Jewelry, etc.,.

2. Yangon Full Day Sightseeing

1) Shwedagone Pagoda which enshrines strands of Buddha's hair and other holy relics.

2) City Hall Yangon is centrally located in downtown Yangon. The construction of this building started in 1926 and ended in 1936. The building is noted on the Yangon City Heritage List.

3) The Independence Monument is located in the center of the **Mahabandoola Park** which commemorates the independence of Burma from the British in 1948.

4) Scotts (BogyokeAung San) Market is an old colonial building which is popular shopping area for tourists.

5) ChaukHtatGyi Pagoda which is a beautiful and huge reclining Buddha image 70 meter (230 feet) long in the post of rest: the head is lifted up by the right arm at the elbow.



6) SulePagoda is an excellent landmark; located in the heart of Yangon. The golden pagoda is an unusual in that its octagonal shape continues right up to the bell and inverted bowl.

3. Bago Full Day Sightseeing

- 1) The 1,000-year-old Shwemawdaw Pagoda** is a famous religious place and holds the record for the tallest pagoda in the country.
- 2) Taukkyan War Cemetery** which is the largest of the three war cemeteries in Myanmar. It contains the graves of 6,374 soldiers who died in the Second World War, the graves of 52 soldiers who died in Burma during the First World War.
- 3) Kyakhatwine Monastery;** where many monks live while studying Buddha's literature and you can see population of monks having their lunch with total silence at 10:30 AM.
- 4) Shwethalyaung Reclining Buddha,** (circa 994 AD) having 55 meters long, is one of the largest reclining Buddha images in Myanmar.
- 5) MahazediPaya**(which simply means the Great Pagoda) originally built by King Bayinnaung, subsequently destroyed by an earthquake in 1930 which rebuilt in 1982.
- 6) Kanbawzathadi Palace** (circa 1556 AD) which was built by king Bayinnaung (Sinphyumyarshin), the founder of the second Myanmar Empire and where exit the ruin of city wall 20 gates.

4. Kyaikhtiyo Day Return Trip

Pick up hotel and drive to Kyaikhtiyo. The distance from Yangon to Kyaikhtiyo is about 219km and it normally takes about four hours drive to reach.

Upon arrival at Kin Pun "base camp" in Kyaikhtiyo, you need to switch to a shuttle open truck car to reach basement of **Kyaikhtiyo Pagoda**. This pagoda is a huge boulder completely covered by gold leaf sand delicately balanced on the edge of a cliff near the top of Kyaikhtiyo Mountain and one of the most reserved Buddhist Shrines. They believe that they feel lucky when they touch the golden rock; it brings happiness and blessing to their life. However, only men are allowed to touch the rock, women can only pray from a distance. And the saying about Kyaikhtiyo Pagoda is that if they come to Kyaikhtiyo three times in one visit, all of their prayers will come true.

5. Sightseeing in Bagan (Famous Architect City in Myanmar) (2 Day/1 Night) Program

Day 1: Yangon – Bagan(By AM Flight)



The visit in Bagan starts with a prototype of real Myanmar Stupa; "**Shwezigon Pagoda**", which was started by King Anawrahta and was completed by King Kyansittha.

Continue a visit to a massive temple with the finest brick-work "**Dhammayangyi**", the highest of Bagan Temples; "**Thabinyu Temple**" and the famous "**Ananda Patho**" which has four huge Standing-Buddha images (9.5 meter), four high teakwood gates (10.6 meter) and the numerous seated figures in niches around the galleried interior. The "**Ananda Patho**" is also known as the best preserved masterpieces of Mon architecture.

After lunch, experience a culture time at the traditional **Lacquer-ware workshops**. In the evening, enjoy a short romantic sunset boat along the Ayeyarwaddy River. Taste dinner at local restaurant and overnight at hotel.

Day 2: Bagan – Yangon (By PM Flight)

After breakfast, a visit to Colorful "**Nyaung-U local market**" to see lifestyle of local people. Then visit to, "**Shwesandaw Paya**" which was the first Stupa build in Myanmar and "**Dhamarazika Stupa**" which is the largest Pentagonal Stupa in Bagan possesses a panoramic view of the Bagan area. The 13rd Century mural paintings can be seen at the famous "**Payathonzu Temple**".

After lunch at local restaurant, proceed to "**Manuha Temple**" with gigantic Buddha Images which was built in Mon Style at the end of 11th Century by the captured King Manuha. And continue a visit to "**Myingaba Gu Byaungkyi Temple**" which was preserved by UNESCO for its ancient mural colorful paintings. In the afternoon,



transfer to airport for your flight and upon arrival in Yangon, your car and guide will welcome you.

6. Sightseeing in Mandalay (2 Day/1 Night) Program

Day 1: Yangon – Mandalay (By AM Flight)

Mahamuni Pagoda which is spectacular Buddha image covered with thick layers of gold leaves and the holiest pagoda in Mandalay.

Mandalay Palace which was the last royal seat of Myanmar and constructed between 1857 and 1859 as part of King Mindon’s founding of the new royal capital city of Mandalay and followed the traditional Burmese palace design, inside a walled fort surrounded by a moat.

Golden Shwenandaw monastery noted for its exquisite wood carving and **Atumashi (Incomparable) Monastery** originally built in 1857 by King Mindon, **Kuthodaw pagoda** with its 729 marble stone slabs of Buddhist scriptures (the World’s Biggest Book) which have been designated the World Heritage by UNESCO.

Mandalay Hill which is famous its mystical religious background especially famous for unforgettable vista of an eastern sunset city seen from top of the hill. And then enjoy dinner and overnight at hotel

Day 2: Mandalay – Yangon (By PM Flight)

Taking a leisurely boat trip along the Ayeyarwaddy River cross to **Mingun** and see the world’s largest ringing bronze Mingun Bell cast in 1808 and weighting 90 tons, and the wonderful Mingun Buddhist Home for the Aged founded in 1915, **Hsinphyumae Pagoda and Mya Thein Dan Zedi.**

Visit Amarapura including Mahagandayone Monastery where more than 1000 monks follow Buddha’s teachings and observe young monks listening to the teaching of eminent Theravada monks.

Again, sightseeing to 1208 meters long **U Bein Bridge** across the Taungthaman Lake (the world’s longest Teakwood Bridge).
